E.g.1: In 2016, in Belgium, the employment rate of men was 72,3% and that of women 63,01%. 10,7% of the male wage earners and 44,8% of the female ones worked part-time.
E.g.2: In 2016, in Belgium, there were 302.773 self-employed men (66,7%) and 150.628 self-employed women (33,3%). 23% of the self-employed women employed staff, while for men this was 34%. Research of the *Entrepreneurship Database Program* in 150 countries indicated that the average amount of money loaned by self-employed men was 22.569 dollar and that of self-employed women 9.248 dollar.
